What is a typical day like for you?

I always get up early, at about 6 am, so that I can catch the morning rush to work. I get a lot of passengers then.

Is the morning a good time of day for your kind of job?

Well, it's not bad, but there's always a lot of traffic at that time so journeys can take a long time. At night it's not so bad. It's quiet and peaceful because there are no buses or tube runs after midnight. I got a lot of work then. Sometimes, I have to drive out of London.

Do you work all day?

No. I stop for lunch and have an afternoon sleep. Then I go back to work at about 5. At about 2 or 3 a.m. I go back to bed. I suppose I have a strange routine!

Do you enjoy being a taxi driver?

Oh, yes! You meet all kinds of people, even famous people. Sometimes passengers are rude but usually they are interesting and I like to talk to them.
